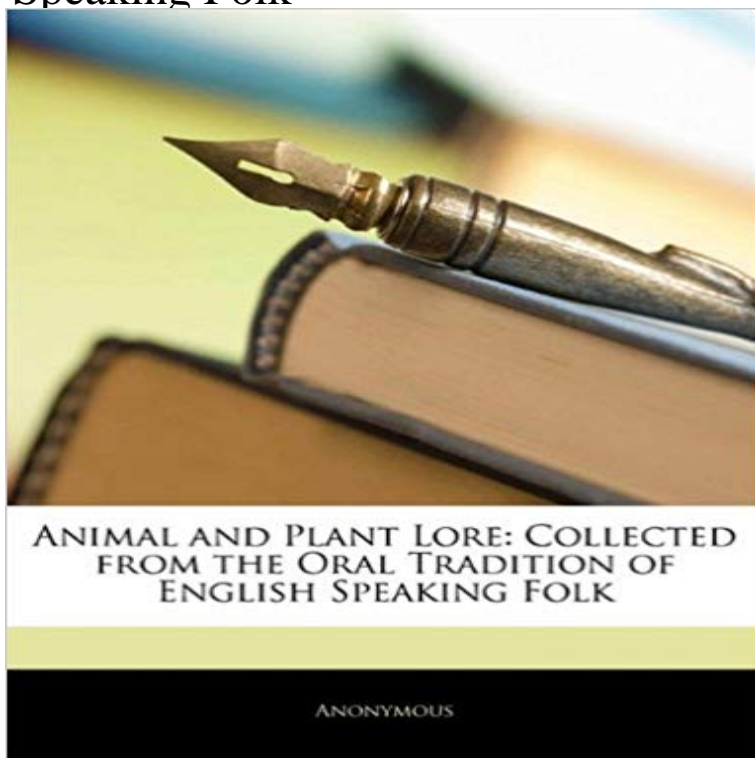


Animal and Plant Lore: Collected from the Oral Tradition of English Speaking Folk
