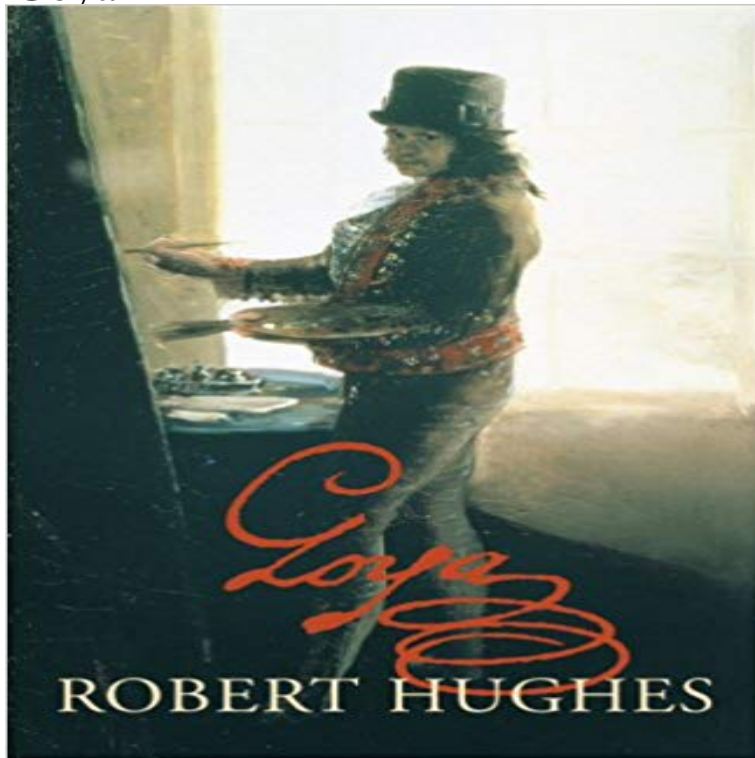


Goya



The starting point of this journey through Goyas life in 18th-century Spain is Hughes own first encounter with the artists work when he was a student in Australia. The remainder of the book charts the artists entire career, describing his painted and graphic oeuvre within its historical context. Particular attention is paid to Goyas patrons, his favourite themes (portraits, scenes of warfare and terror, satirical prints and so on), his criticism of the Catholic Church and encounters with the Inquisition, his fierce anti-war stance and his reputation in his lifetime. What emerges is a picture of an artist deeply engaged with life around him and fully committed to documenting it with an unflinching eye for truth and injustice.

In 1824 Francisco Goya arrived in the city of Bordeaux as a self-imposed exile from Spain. He was seventy-eight years old, stone deaf (since 1793) and Francisco Jose de Goya y Lucientes (Fig. 1) was a painter endowed with a great expressive capacity. His work, which was carried out between the end of the 18th and the beginning of the 19th century, is considered one of the last of the Old Masters of painting, as well as the first of the moderns. Goya is a city in the south-west of the province of Corrientes in the Argentine Mesopotamia. It has about 77,349 inhabitants as of the 2010 census [INDEC].
