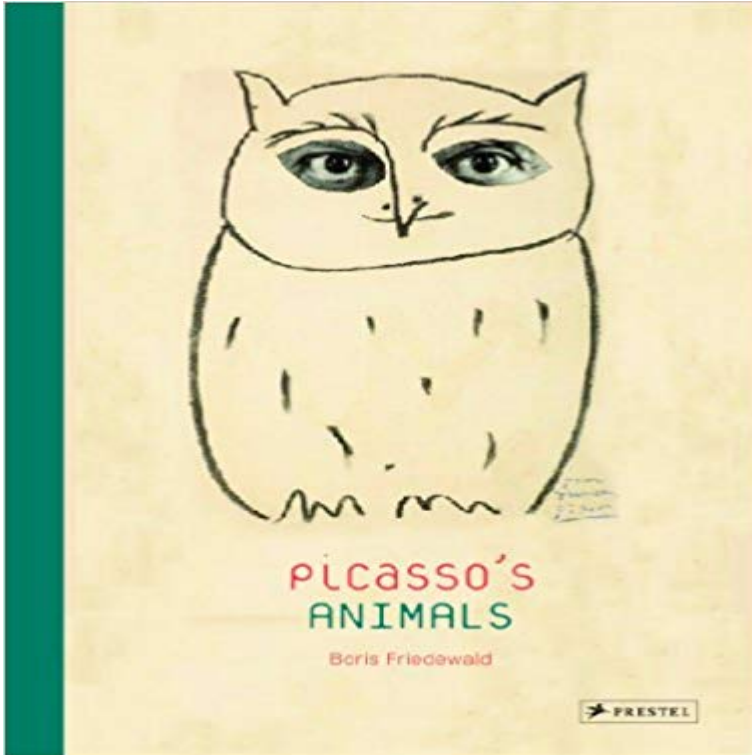


Picassos Animals
