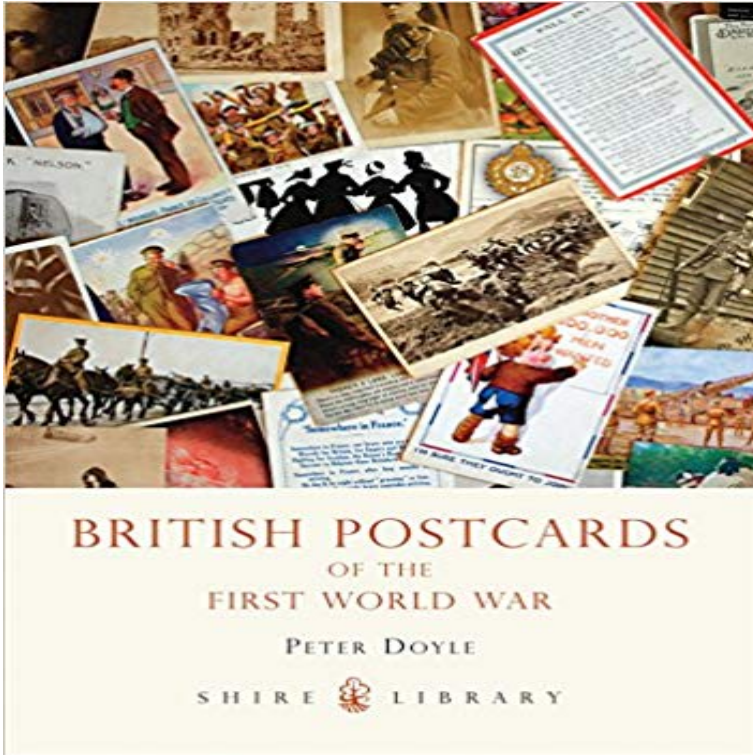


British Postcards of the First World War (Shire Library)
