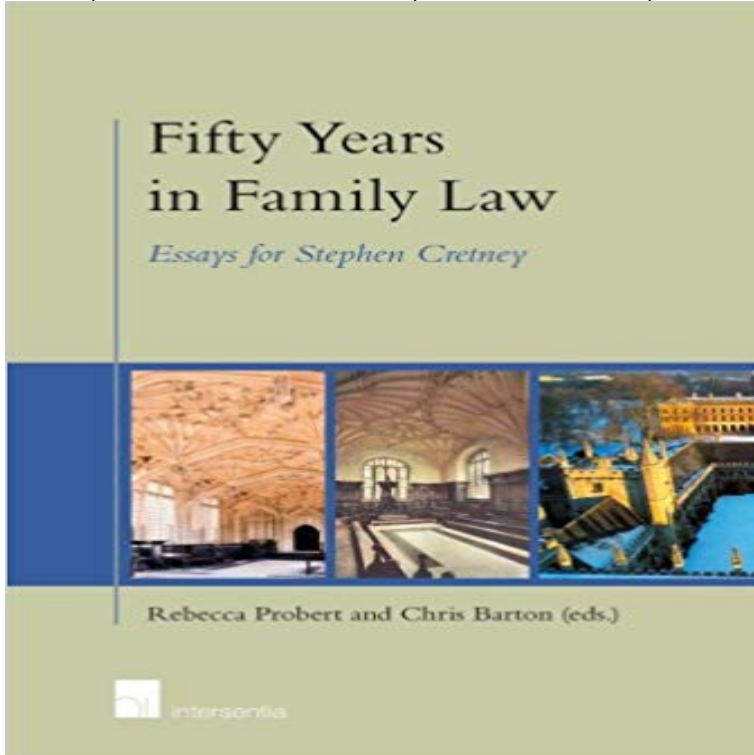


Fifty Years in Family Law: Essays for Stephen Cretney
