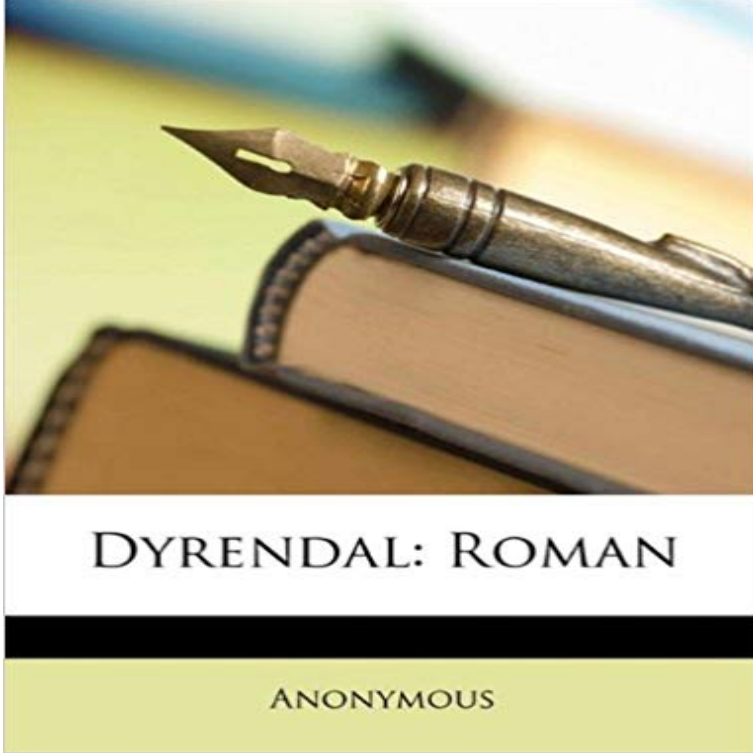


Dyrendal: Roman (Norwegian Edition)
