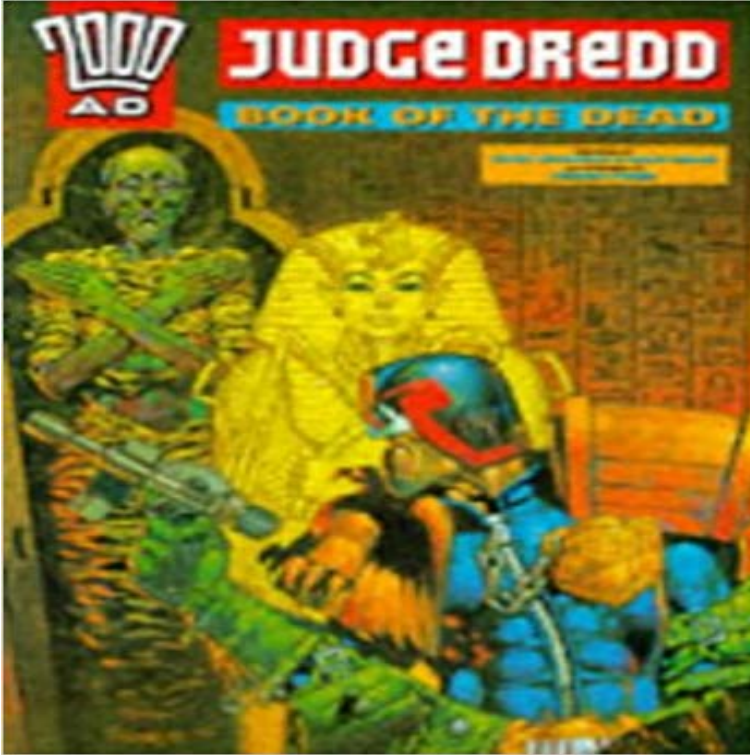


## Judge Dredd-Book of the Dead (2000 AD)
