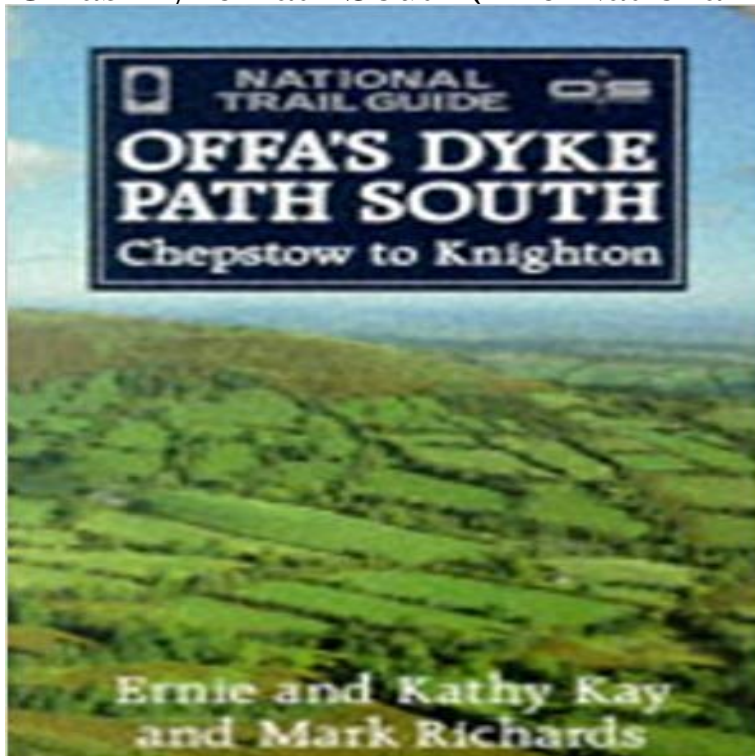


Offas Dyke Path South (The National Trail Guides)
