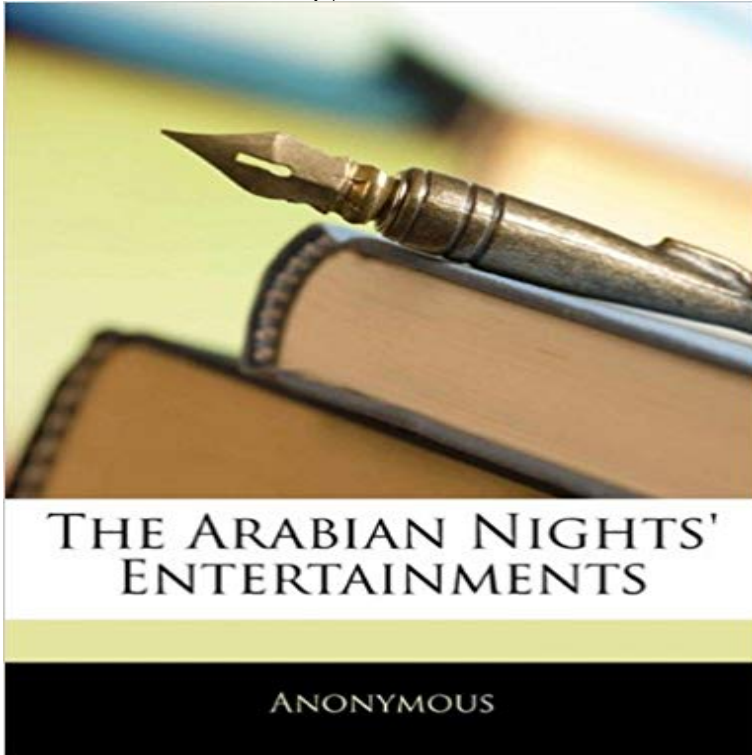


The Arabian Nights Entertainments
