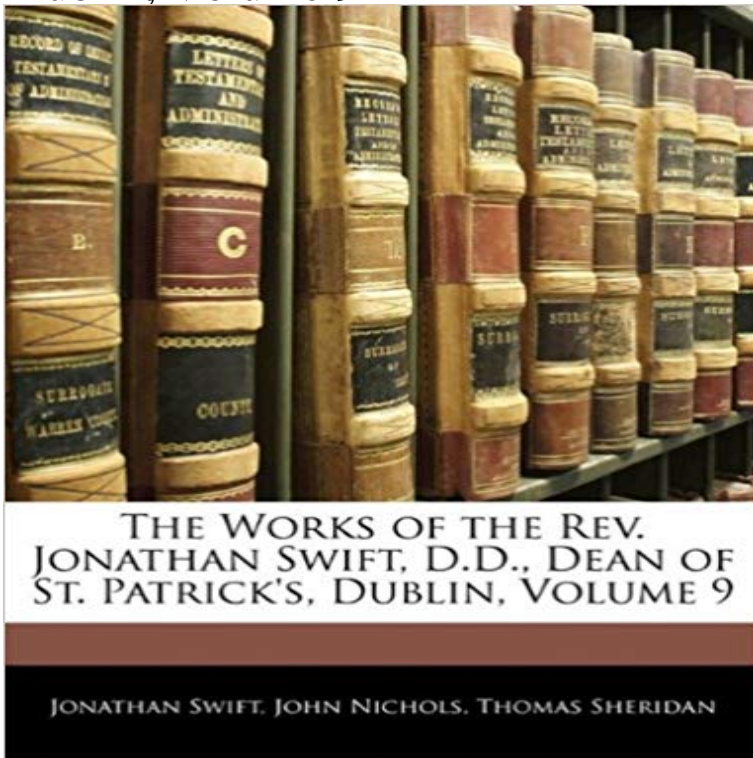


The Works of the Rev. Jonathan Swift, D.D., Dean of St. Patricks, Dublin, Volume 9
