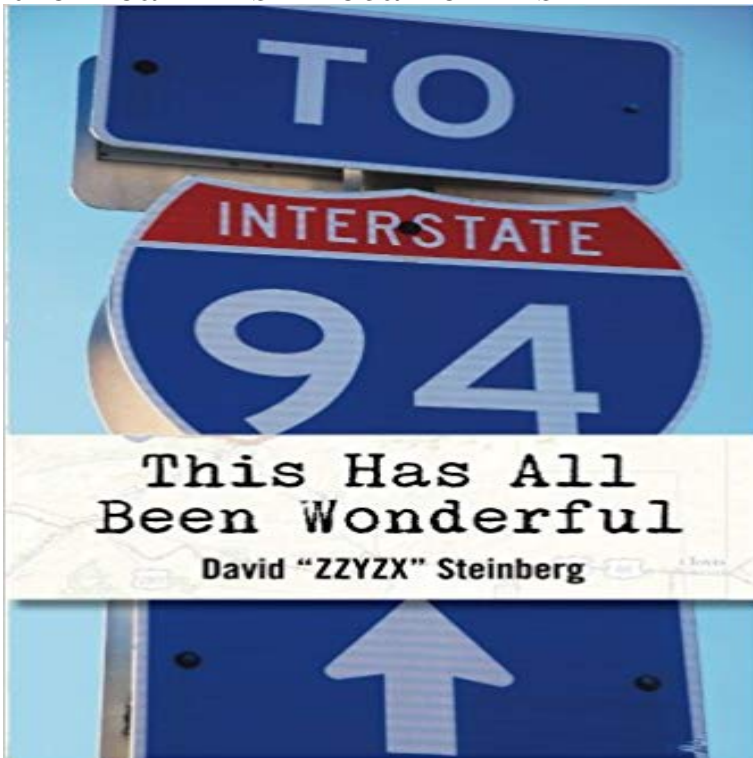


This Has All Been Wonderful: A Travel Monologue from Summer 1994, the Year Phish Became Phish
