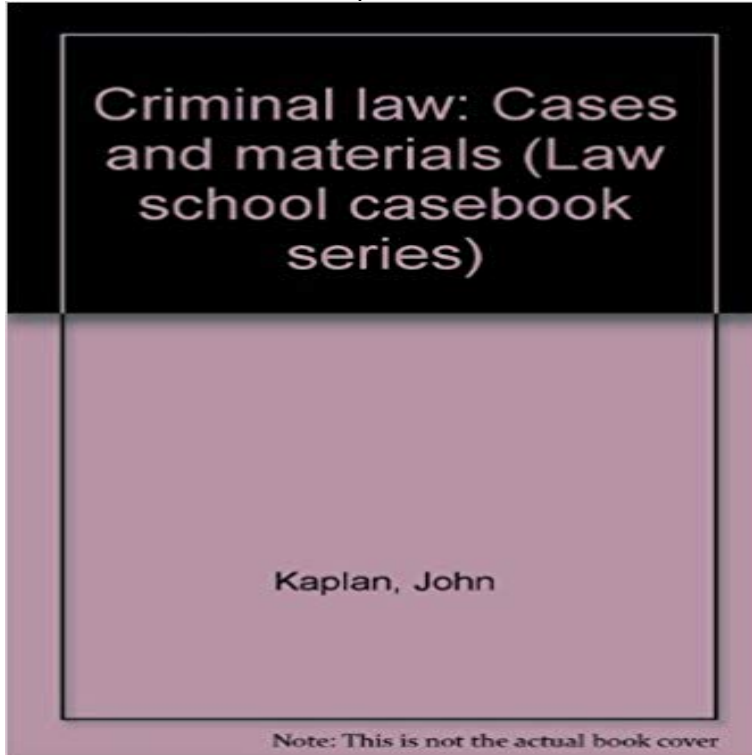


## Criminal Law 2e (Law School Casebook Series)
