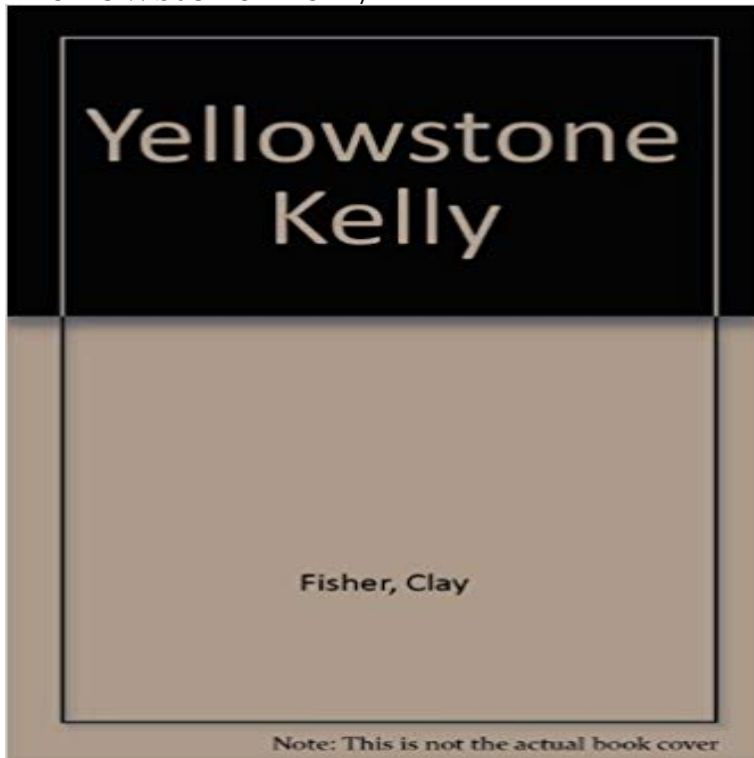


Yellowstone Kelly
